Roots of our Prayers: 2 Thessalonians 1.1-12

- Thank God for our growing faith and love (v. 3)
- Thank Him for the strength He's given to persevere (v. 4)
- Ask Him to empower you to live a life of meaning (v. 5, 11)
- Ask for our good desires to be worked out in our actions (v. 11)
- Pray that Jesus would be glorified in you, and you in Him (v. 13)

Praying for Others: 1 Thessalonians 3.9-13

- Thank God for how others give you joy (v. 9)
- Ask God to serve others' spiritual needs (v. 10)
- Ask God for others' love to increase and overflow for all people (v. 12)
- Ask that others would be anchored in holiness through God's strength (v. 13)

Praying through our Discontent: Philippians 1.9-11

- Ask God to marry our knowledge and love, and to grow them both (v. 9)
- Ask for the ability to discern what is best in your life, and for the ability to live it out (v. 10)
- Ask Jesus to fill us with His Spirit, that we can live good lives for Him (v. 11)

Praying to the King: Ephesians 1.15-23

- Give thanks for how God has worked through His church (vv. 15-16)
- Ask Him for wisdom for yourself and others in the church (v. 17)
- Ask God to keep the future reality of the new heavens and earth firmly fixed in our present (v. 18)
- Thank God for His power at work for good in our lives (v. 18-19)
- Ask God for the wonder of serving the sovereign King to connect with our daily life (vv. 20-23)

Praying for Power: Ephesians 3.14-23

- Ask that you would depend more on His power and less than your own (v. 16)
- Ask that our knowledge of God and love for each other would lead to a further knowledge and love that God has for us (v. 17-18)
- Ask that we would bask in this knowledge, enjoying God and being filled by Him (v. 19)

Praying for God's Work: Romans 15.14-33

- Pray for opportunities for yourself and others to preach the gospel in new places (v. 20)
- Pray for more churches to be planted to reach new people with the gospel
- Join in others' struggles by seeking God through prayer (v. 30)
- Pray for others to not be hindered by persecution, freely able to join God's work (v. 31)
- Pray for our church to be a place of joy, refreshment, and peace for all (v. 33)
